

HHRO Work plan for Service Hubs

January- December 2019

HHRO intends to focus on providing the following services to IDPs and refugees in Erbil and Nineveh Plain:

1- Improve the resilience of youth through Art: HHRO will provide youth of age 6-17 from the IDPs and refugees in Erbil and in Nineveh Plain the opportunity to use Art (Painting, music, and traditional hand crafts) to express themselves and to preserve their culture and tradition. HHRO will use its network of volunteers to provide the training courses. Each course will last for three months. At the end of each course, HHRO will hold a one day festival to present the product of the youth and their talents. Also, HHRO will hold a round table discussion bringing together youth and stakeholders to discuss issues of concerns to youth in camp. HHRO will hold a two day grand festival in December providing a chance for all trainees to present and sell their products. HHRO will invite well known figures to attend the festival and will use the income generated to support the children in the camp.

Targeted group: Youth of 6-17 years of age from IDPs and Refugee communities in Erbil.

Duration and Frequency: Three courses during 2019, each lasts three months, each followed by a one day festival. A two day grand festival will be held in December.

2- Legal Clinic: HHRO will provide IDPs and refugees with Legal Counseling and Education to promote Human Rights and peaceful co-existence. HHRO will conduct a series of seminars to educate IDPs and Refugees on: Human Rights, with special focus on the right to work and social protection; the legal requirements to obtain missing documents; compensation; and voluntary return. Also, HHRO will use its network of volunteers to provide free consultation and legal assistance to those in need. . HHRO will provide attendees with means for communication with its network of volunteer lawyers to provide assistance.

Targeted group: Members of IDPs and Refugee communities in camps in Erbil and Nineveh Plain.

Duration and Frequency: HHRO will hold a seminar every three months on one of the topics. HHRO network of volunteer lawyers will be available on daily basis to provide the legal assistance to those in need.
